Terms & Conditions

- 1. The Challenge Mission: Driving innovation in diagnostic test system market and improving quality of life. Supporting early-stage developers taking an idea through to a small-scale, basic diagnostic test.
- GE Healthcare's co-sponsor in this competition is Mologic Ltd. www.mologic.co.uk.
 Mologic Ltd. is an end-to-end diagnostics service partner. Participants in our competition can
 make use of their offering including custom reagent development, recombinant protein
 expression, antibody production and custom production that incorporates low-mid volume
 manufacturing.
- 3. The Prize will be a 3-day coaching engagement on assay development with Dr. Klaus Hochleitner, Global Technology Lead Specialist for Diagnostics at GE Healthcare Life Sciences plus any additional Mologic Ltd. and GE Healthcare staff as GE Healthcare may determine are required. The prize also includes a dinner sponsored by Mologic Ltd.
- 4. Applications have to be submitted via email to: Whatman.Diagnostics@ge.com
- 5. Incomplete applications or applications received after the deadline date indicated in these terms and conditions will not be considered.
- 6. All applications will be independently assessed and rated by a panel of assay design experts from GE Healthcare Life Sciences' product development teams. Each application will be judged on (1) the significance of the project to the diagnostic test market, (2) the commercialization potential and (3) innovation.
- 7. The following projects and applicants are eligible for submission to this competition:
 - a. Users with an idea or a marker for a diagnostic test system needing help with test design and development
 - b. The diagnostic test systems must use a lateral-flow, flow-through, dipstick or line blot platform.
 - c. The diagnostics test systems can be either molecular- or immune-based as long as they use one of the above-mentioned platforms.
 - d. The projects must be innovative and have a positive impact on quality of life
 - e. For these test systems there is no simple test kit commercially available so far
 - f. All submissions must be made in English
- 8. Applicant/Laboratory must be based in Europe. Applications must be in form of a project outline include the following information:
 - a. Target molecule(s) to be detected
 - b. Details of the sample type being analyzed.
 - c. Description of the current method of detection of the molecule
 - d. Reasons(s) why is it important to have a simple test
 - e. Description of what you have available for the development work (equipment, reagents)
 - f. Previous experience with this/these specific molecule(s) to be detected
 - g. Idea for commercialization of the test: potential market size, who would be the endusers

- h. Confirmation if applicant has available facilities and would like GE staff to visit them, or if they would like to visit the GE Healthcare Membrane Centre of Excellence in Dassel for the development activity.
- 9. Number of Submissions: There is no limitation on the number of submissions that a given investigator or institution can participate in or submit. Investigators are encouraged to submit applications for all research projects that align with the goals and rules of this competition.
- 10. GE Healthcare confirms to treat all submitted applications as confidential. All proprietary information of the applicant which is submitted as part of the application will remain the proprietary information of the applicant.
- 11. A non-disclosure agreement will be signed between the winner and GE Healthcare.
- 12. Each applicant will receive a free of charge Whatman Diagnostics Starter kit, which contains samples of all grade of CF, GF and Nitrocellulose GEHC supply, in order to allow applicants to start developing their test.
- 13. With their submission applicants confirm that they have the authority to participate in this competition and provide the required project information.
- 14. Applicants are responsible for abiding by their employer's policies regarding participation in this competition. They are responsible for confirming with their university, institution or other such relationship that their application does not violate any policies set by that university, institution or other such relationship.
- 15. The winner grants to GE Healthcare and its affiliated companies the permission to publish its project title, applicant name & title, company/institution name, city and country when promoting this competition. Furthermore, the winner grants permission for GE Healthcare to take photos during the 3-day coaching workshop and use this for promotion purposes, for example during conferences, on the web and in social media.
- 16. USE OF DATA: Entry into the Competition constitutes applicant's irrevocable permission, at no additional compensation or consideration, for GE Healthcare, acting as data controller to use the personal information submitted during the application process.
