



Cerianna is used with Positron Emission Tomography ay imaging to detect a specific protein called the estrogen receptor on breast cancer tumors that have recurred or spread from their original site. Cerianna is used as an adjunct to biopsy patients with recurrent or metastatic breast cancer.
