GE Healthcare Event COVID-19 DEFENSE PROTOCOLS AND BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS

Welcome to **GE Healthcare Event**

We would like to kindly remind you the importance of following the protocols regarding to COVID-19 before, during and after the event for your and other's health and safety as events can contribute to the spread of COVID-19 via travelers who attend these conventions.

None of the below advices & recommendations shall supersede local regulation and the most stringent behaviors shall be followed.

General considerations



- Be aware that the GEHC should continually assess, based on current conditions, whether to postpone, cancel, or significantly reduce the number of attendees.
- Be aware that GE limits the number of attendees based on Covid situation.
- If you are a "closed contact" or you feel ill or have any symptoms of COVID-19, reschedule your visit.

Use of public transport



- Whenever possible buy travel tickets online or use contactless payment if possible.
- Avoid peak times and take quieter routes with fewer changes.
- Minimize your luggage.
- When possible, use a less busy route and reduce the number of changes help to keep distance from others.
- Surgical masks should be used when travelling, particularly "where social distancing is hard to maintain"

Use of taxis and private hire vehicles

- At taxi ranks try to keep your distance from people outside your household, where possible.
- Taxi & private hire vehicle operators are likely to have put in place measures including social distancing.
- Consider wearing a surgical or FFP2 masks in an enclosed space where social distancing isn't possible.

Use cars and other vehicles

- Avoid public transport to reduce the risk of Covid.
- Avoid sharing a vehicle with people.
- Limit the time at petrol stations and motorway services.
- Try to keep your distance from other people and if possible.
- Wash your hands for at least 20 seconds or sanitize your hands when arriving and leaving.
- Be aware of the surfaces you or others touch.
- If possible, drive with open widows and turn off air recirculation
- if possible, payment needs to be done by contactless.

Site arrival



- Access to the events will be strictly controlled (on invitation only)
- Unauthorized/non-invited visitors will not have access the event
- Avoid physical contact such as shaking hands.
- GEHC will provide alcohol-based hand sanitizer and FFP2 masks. Only FFP2 masks are acceptable. Single layer face coverings such as gaiters/bandanas are NOT PERMITTED.
- 5 minutes safety briefing:
 - Attendees will be reminded to report any symptoms/illnesses or exposure to COVID immediately GEHC will enforce the COVID defense protocols with employees and attendees and a passive screening questionnaire will be conducted.
 - o GEHC will be taken, temperature on voluntary basis at the main entrance.
 - If fever >37,5 °C, we will ask to leave the event.

Event



- GEHC will
 - o adjust venue sizes to accommodate min 4 m² per attendee.
 - ensure frequent cleaning and disinfection particularly of frequently touched surfaces (e.g. the tables, door handles, all surfaces).
 - o remind Personal Hygiene to all the visitors during breaks and throughout the show.
 - o supply and mandate the use of proper personal protective equipment e.g. FFP2 masks,
 - o facilitate the disposal of Waste material produced during the event (cleaning, masks, etc.) to unsorted garbage.
- No group dinners and gatherings will be organized.





- Report any symptoms developed within 14 days after the event
- The details of the emergency operations plan should be based on the size and duration of events, demographics of the participants, complexity of event operations, and type of on-site services and activities event may offer.
- For the persons impacted by the tracing, GE Healthcare will contact and advise attendees to monitor their health.
